Peter Graham is a Canadian singer-songwriter from the village of Millbrook, Ontario. Following more than a decade of songwriting, including training at Bishop’s and the Royal Conservatory, Peter is releasing his first full-length album *Despite Where We’ve Been*.

A collection of diligently polished alternative folk songs, *Despite Where We’ve Been* features strong vocals and concise lyrics, carried by the collective efforts of established musicians.

The album opens in hopeful turmoil with the track *Fireworks and Liquor* whose chorus repeats “If I don’t bend, if I don’t break, there could be purpose” offering a glimpse in the window of a struggle to fit in. This line prepares the listener for songs of conflict and reflections told with an underlying hope and acceptance.

In 2017 Peter released his first EP *Nowhere in Tacoma* which received airplay across Canada and internationally. The response to his music has included the following reviews and awards:
